Our invited presenter is **Mr. Rich Madel**:



*Rich Madel is a Spanish Teacher and the Chairperson of the Department of World Languages at the Colonial School District in Plymouth Meeting, PA. Focusing on best practices in world language instruction, he has presented conference sessions and led workshops to language teachers in a variety of local, state, regional, and national contexts. Rich is currently pursuing a doctorate with an emphasis on communicative classroom practices that support second language acquisition. Mr. Madel's department also received a 2017 Silver Globe PEP award from the Pennsylvania Modern Language Association (PSMLA). Rich also contributes to the conversation among language teachers on social media via **Twitter @SrMadel**.*
